A further conference call took place with the management of Aer Lingus earlier today. During the call management confirmed that they had registered to participate in the recently announced wage subsidy scheme and they were in the process of seeking clarity as how the scheme might be applied to further support the income of workers in Aer Lingus.

The company have also confirmed that, next week, people will be paid a minimum of 50% of their gross wages.

A further conference call has been arranged for next Tuesday morning and it is hoped that at that stage that we will be in a position to provide more detailed information including what if any action members should take to secure entitlements from social welfare.
