**Re: Career Pathway Dispute** 

Dear Mr Delamere,

I refer to our ongoing engagement under the auspices of the WRC in relation to the Career Pathway Dispute.

Further to our meeting of Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> October, the Health and Welfare Divisional Dispute Committee met to consider the HSE request for a further period of engagement give the constructive nature of talks over the past 6 weeks.

While the parties have made significant progress in relation to the outstanding process in Primary Care, less progress has been made to agree a bespoke staff to senior process outside of Primary Care. **This remains of significant concern to Fórsa.** However, it is clear from the discussions that we have not exhausted all potential solutions, and the HSE is committed to meaningfully exploring all options.

On that basis I wish to advise the following:

- Fórsa agree to a further 6 weeks of direct engagement under the auspices of the WRC (up to and including 30<sup>th</sup> November 2023).
- The parties will set out a schedule of meetings for the coming 6 weeks to keep the momentum of current discussions.
- The parties will revert to the WRC in December with either agreement / requirement for further conciliation. It is our preferred approach to seek that date jointly from the Commission now.
- The industrial action previously scheduled, remains suspended while these talks take place.
