On public service pay and working time

- 1. Will you commit to negotiations to reach a pay deal to succeed the PSSA?
- 2. Will you commit to inflation-plus pay increases for the public sector?
- 3. Will you commit to addressing the issue of additional hours introduced as an emergency crisis measure as part of the 2013 pay deal?

On trade union rights

- 1. Will you support legislation that strengthens workers' legal rights to be represented by the union of their choice?
- 2. Will you support legislation to tackle bogus self-employment?

On climate action

- 1. Will you set legally-binding targets to reduce carbon emissions?
- 2. Will you establish a Just Transition Task Force?

Community employment supervisors

1. Will you commit to resolving the dispute with CE Supervisors in line with the 2008 Labour Court recommendation?

Education

- 1. Will you ensure an end to the two-tier pay system for school secretaries?
- 2. Will you commit to maintaining the link between each SNA and their specific student?
- 3. Will you commit to progressively increasing higher education funding to OECD average levels over the lifetime of the next government?

Local services and democracy

- 1. Will you commit to an early referendum to enshrine public ownership of water in our constitution?
- 2. Will you commit to the re-municipalisation of waste services by local authorities?
- 3. Will you commit to the establishment of a new, local authority-led, cost rental public housing model?
- 4. Will you commit to a large-scale public home-building programme?

Health and social services

- 1. Will you support the full implementation of Sláintecare?
- 2. Will you support the necessary recruitment of health and social care professionals to meet existing service demands and the needs of Sláintecare?
- 3. Will you work to establish a structured, fair and sustainable funding model for 'section 39' agencies?
- 4. Will you (and your party) invest in mental health services, and consult with workers and service-users to develop appropriate services?

Civil service

- 1. Will you make the necessary amendment to the Industrial Relations Acts to give civil servants access to the WRC and Labour Court?
- 2. Will you and your party legislate to allow the majority of civil servants to engage in political activity?

Other issues

- 1. Will you commit to the establishment of a citizens' assembly to explore a shorter working week?
- 2. Will you support the re-introduction of tax relief on trade union subscriptions?
- 3. Will you quickly introduce laws to require employers to publish their organisation's gender pay gap?
- 4. Will you support publicly-provided and publicly-funded affordable childcare for working people?
