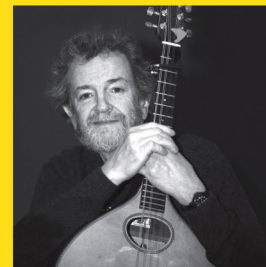
CULTURAL FESTIVAL
